Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least six months prior to the wedding. A Pre-Cana process is required. Please contact the office.

Marriage Tribunal: Deacon Jerry is a trained Case Assistant. Petitioners may speak with him for guidance.

Baptism: Baptism is conferred on the third Saturday of every month at 11:00 am or during a regular weekend mass. Parents must be registered and participating parishioners for a minimum of three months. Parents and Godparents must attend a baptism class and submit godparent documents. In order to obtain more information or to schedule a baptism, please contact the office.

First Reconciliation/First Communion: School-aged children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. **This is a 2-year program.** Children must have attended a prior year of faith formation.

Confirmation: Children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. Confirmation preparation is a 2-year program.

***All Sacramental students are required to submit baptism certificate and long form of birth certificate.**

Rite of Christian Initiation Adults (RCIA): Contact Deacon Michael Heidkamp to discuss conversion to the Catholic faith.

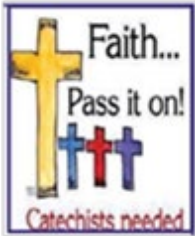

Permanent Diaconate Applications 2028

The Office of the Permanent Diaconate is accepting applications for diaconate candidates for the Class of 2028. The applications must be received by the office for evaluation by Oct. 15, 2022, to prepare for the beginning of the discernment process, which begins in January 2023. Applicants must meet the following to enter formation:

1. Meet with pastor to express an interest in the formation program
2. Normally, between the ages of 30-55 at time of application (final decision rests with the bishop)
3. Actively involved in parish ministry for a minimum of three years
4. Catholic for five years or more
5. High school diploma or GED at minimum
6. In good standing with the Catholic Church

The Retrouvaille Online Marriage Retreat is an intensive weekend experience that offers help and hope for couples that are struggling in the face of a marital crisis and may be considering divorce or separation. Couples can experience the weekend retreat online from the privacy of your own home. You and your spouse will spend the weekend learning an effective communication process from couples that have experienced similar marriage difficulties.
