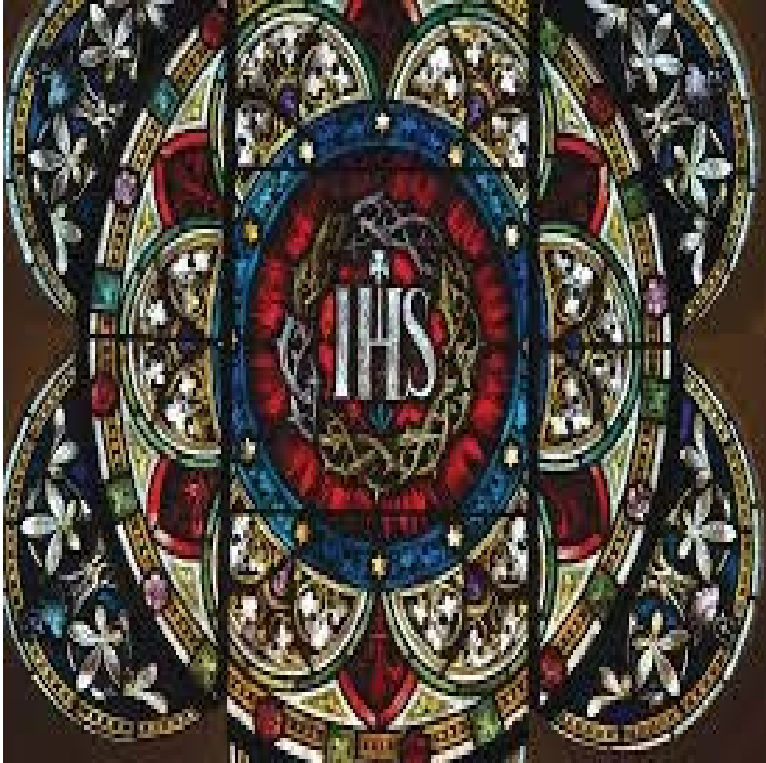

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least six months prior to the wedding. A Pre-Cana process is required. Please contact the office.

Marriage Tribunal: Deacon Jerry is a trained Case Assistant. Petitioners may speak with him for guidance.

Baptism: Baptism is conferred on the third Saturday of every month at 11:00 am or during a regular weekend mass. Parents must be registered and participating parishioners for a minimum of three months. Parents and Godparents must attend a baptism class and submit godparent documents. In order to obtain more information or to schedule a baptism, please contact the office.

First Reconciliation/First Communion: School-aged children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. **This is a 2-year program.** Children must have attended a prior year of faith formation.

Confirmation: Children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. Confirmation preparation is a 2-year program.

***All Sacramental students are required to submit baptism certificate and long form of birth certificate.**

Anointing of the Sick and Pastoral Visitation

OFFERTORY ENVELOPES

The envelope system helps the Parish Office to determine a household's parishioner status (active or inactive). Weekly envelopes in the Sunday collection basket indicate regular Mass attendance. Should a parishioner come to Mass without an envelope, he/she may use the generic envelope (available in the back of the church). Note: **Please do not share your envelopes with another parishioner.**

We also use the envelope tracking system to provide the following:

- ◆ To receive Sacraments in the parish (Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, Marriage)
- ◆ For permission letters to marry or baptize at another church
- ◆ For Sponsor letters for Baptism and/or Confirmation
- ◆ To receive parishioner tuition rates at a Catholic school.

If you are not registered with the parish, registration forms can be found at the back of the church or online at spbcc.org. If you are unsure of your registration status or are not receiving envelopes, visit the church office during regular business hours. St. Philip Benizi and Our Lady of Peace are very blessed by the generosity of many who share their time, talent, and treasure in the loving service of others.
