Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least six months prior to the wedding. A Pre-Cana process is required. Please contact the office.

Marriage Tribunal: Deacon Jerry is a trained Case Assistant. Petitioners may speak with him for guidance.

Baptism: Baptism is conferred on the third Saturday of every month at 11:00 am or during a regular weekend mass. Parents must be registered and participating parishioners for a minimum of three months. Parents and Godparents must attend a baptism class and submit godparent documents. In order to obtain more information or to schedule a baptism, please contact the office.

First Reconciliation/First Communion: School-aged children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. **This is a 2-year program.** Children must have attended a prior year of faith formation.

Confirmation: Children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. Confirmation preparation is a 2-year program.

***All Sacramental students are required to submit baptism certificate and long form of birth certificate.**

New Virtus for Employees and Volunteers

Beginning July 1, 2024, The Bishop has decreed that the Diocese of Charleston will begin using the VIRTUS program which includes a comprehensive training program and data management system to maintain safe environments to protect children and the vulnerable.

Existing employees and volunteers will not need to take the new training until after their current training expires. As of July 1, all new employees and volunteers who have not taken the required training will need to create an account in VIRTUS® to complete the training and background screening. Please see Ingrid Myers any Tuesday from 10am - 2pm for more details. If you are a volunteer in any ministry or on any council you must complete this training as soon as possible and are not able to participate in any way until you have done so per Diocesan directives.
