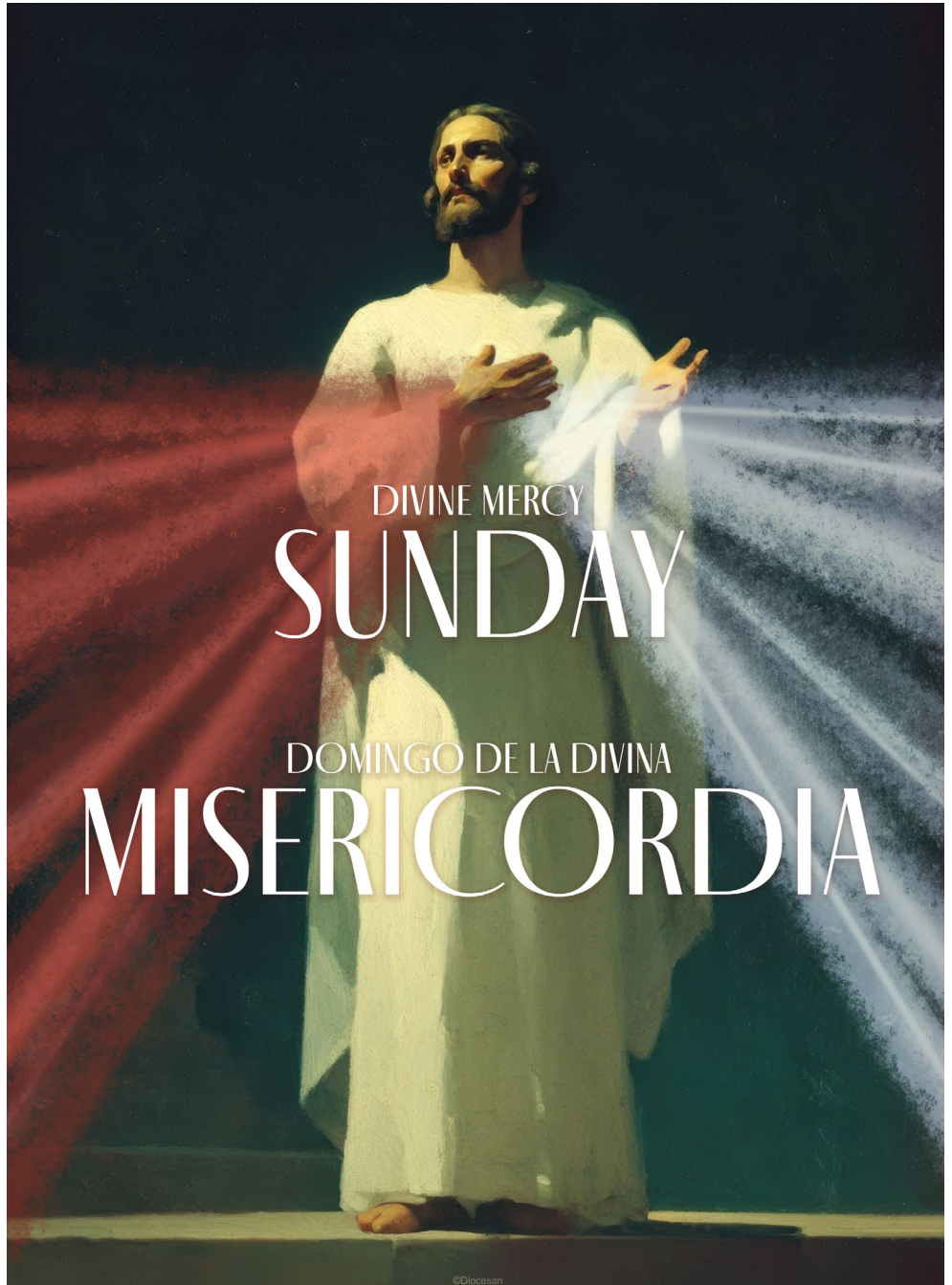

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least six months prior to the wedding. A Pre-Cana process is required. Please contact the office.

Baptism: Baptism is conferred on the third Saturday of every month at 11:00 am or during a regular weekend mass. Parents must be registered and participating parishioners for a minimum of three months. Parents and Godparents must attend a baptism class and submit godparent documents. In order to obtain more information or to schedule a baptism, please contact the office.

First Reconciliation/First Communion: School-aged children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. **This is a 2-year program.** Children must have attended a prior year of faith formation.

Confirmation: Children should enroll in our regular catechetical program. Confirmation preparation is a 2-year program.

***All Sacramental students are required to submit baptism certificate and long form of birth certificate.**

Divine Mercy Sunday April 12, 2026

The Divine Mercy Chaplet is a powerful intercessory prayer, said on rosary beads. Jesus attached many blessings to those who pray the Chaplet, including great mercy at the time of death and for sinners as their last hope for salvation.

The Divine Mercy Image depicts Jesus as He appeared to St. Faustina in her cell on February 22, 1931. Jesus asked St. Faustina to have His Image painted with the signature: "Jesus, I trust in you". Jesus asked that the Image be displayed throughout the world and promised that "... the soul that will venerate this image will not perish".

The Hour of Great Mercy – 3 PM to 4 PM (everyday). Jesus told St. Faustina that, because He died at 3 PM, the hour between 3 and 4 PM is the Hour of Great Mercy, during which she should invoke His mercy for the world, particularly for the conversion of sinners. Jesus also told St. Faustina to pray the Stations of the Cross during this hour.
